## News Headlines

- Firstly, thank you so much for all the donations to the foodbank today. Once again, your generosity means we can help local families who may be in need of additional support.
- We are launching an exciting new project on Monday focussing on keeping children safe on the roads directly outside school and keeping healthy. Before the holidays I told parents about the agreement with the owners of the PAK supermarket car park to allow parents to park there first thing in the morning to ease congestion on Durban Road. On Monday we start the walk to school campaign where children can earn monthly badges when they walk to school. We understand that some children live further away from school so may need to travel by bus or car. Don't worry, your child can get involved too! If you travel by car then parking the car 5 – 10 minute walk away allows your child to 'park and stride'. It also means adults can get an extra few steps in to their daily routine, there is less congestion on Durban Rd and it's a few minutes extra of family chat in the morning.
