- A huge thank you for this term's challenge to improve attendance. Parents know that OFSTED asked the school to improve attendance when they came to visit in June. We have started to make good progress in doing this. We gave out over 180, 100% certificates and bears in assembly today! Last year attendance was 92.3% for the term, this year it is 94.7% Great improvement – well done everyone!
